

In Christ Scripture Verses In The New Testament

(Acts 24:24) Several days later Felix came with his wife Drusilla, who was a Jewess. He sent for Paul and listened to him as he spoke about faith in Christ Jesus.

(Romans 6:11) In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

(Romans 6:23) For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

(Romans 8:1) Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus,

(Romans 8:39) neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

(Romans 9:1) I speak the truth in Christ--I am not lying, my conscience confirms it in the Holy Spirit--

(Romans 12:5) so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

(Romans 15:17) Therefore I glory in Christ Jesus in my service to God.

(Romans 16:3) Greet Priscilla and Aquila, my fellow workers in Christ Jesus.

(Romans 16:7) Greet Andronicus and Junias, my relatives who have been in prison with me. They are outstanding among the apostles, and they were in Christ before I was.

(Romans 16:9-10) Greet Urbanus, our fellow worker in Christ, and my dear friend Stachys. {10} Greet Apelles, tested and approved in Christ. Greet those who belong to the household of Aristobulus.

(1 Corinthians 1:2) To the church of God in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus and called to be holy, together with all those everywhere who call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ--their Lord and ours:

(1 Corinthians 1:4) I always thank God for you because of his grace given you in Christ Jesus.

(1 Corinthians 1:30) It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God--that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.

(1 Corinthians 3:1) Brothers, I could not address you as spiritual but as worldly--mere infants in Christ.

(1 Corinthians 4:10) We are fools for Christ, but you are so wise in Christ! We are weak, but you are strong! You are honored, we are dishonored!

(1 Corinthians 4:15) Even though you have ten thousand guardians in Christ, you do not have many fathers, for in Christ Jesus I became your father through the gospel.

(1 Corinthians 4:17) For this reason I am sending to you Timothy, my son whom I love, who is faithful in the Lord. He will remind you of my way of life in Christ Jesus, which agrees with what I teach everywhere in every church.

(1 Corinthians 15:18-19) Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost. {19} If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are to be pitied more than all men.

(1 Corinthians 15:22) For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.

(1 Corinthians 15:31) I die every day--I mean that, brothers--just as surely as I glory over you in Christ Jesus our Lord.

(1 Corinthians 16:24) My love to all of you in Christ Jesus. Amen.

(2 Corinthians 1:20-21) For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God. {21} Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He anointed us,

(2 Corinthians 2:14) But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumphal procession in Christ and through us spreads everywhere the fragrance of the knowledge of him.

(2 Corinthians 2:17) Unlike so many, we do not peddle the word of God for profit. On the contrary, in Christ we speak before God with sincerity, like men sent from God.

(2 Corinthians 3:14) But their minds were made dull, for to this day the same veil remains when the old covenant is read. It has not been removed, because only in Christ is it taken away.

(2 Corinthians 5:17) Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

(2 Corinthians 5:18-19) All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: {19} that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.

(2 Corinthians 12:2) I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know--God knows.

(2 Corinthians 12:19) Have you been thinking all along that we have been defending ourselves to you? We have been speaking in the sight of God as those in Christ; and everything we do, dear friends, is for your strengthening.

(Galatians 1:22) I was personally unknown to the churches of Judea that are in Christ.

(Galatians 2:4) This matter arose because some false brothers had infiltrated our ranks to spy on the freedom we have in Christ Jesus and to make us slaves.

(Galatians 2:16-17) know that a man is not justified by observing the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by observing the law, because by observing the law no one will be justified. {17} "If, while we seek to be justified in Christ, it becomes evident that we ourselves are sinners, does that mean that Christ promotes sin? Absolutely not!

(Galatians 3:26) You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus,

(Galatians 3:28) There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

(Galatians 5:6) For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision has any value. The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love.

(Ephesians 1:3) Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.

(Ephesians 1:9) And he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ,

(Ephesians 1:12-13) in order that we, who were the first to hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. {13} And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit,

(Ephesians 1:20) which he exerted in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms,

(Ephesians 2:6-7) And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, {7} in order that in the coming ages he might show the incomparable riches of his grace, expressed in his kindness to us in Christ Jesus.

(Ephesians 2:10) For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

(Ephesians 2:13) But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ.

(Ephesians 3:6) This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus.

(Ephesians 3:10-11) His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms, {11} according to his eternal purpose which he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord.

(Ephesians 4:32) Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

(Philippians 1:1) Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, To all the saints in Christ Jesus at Philippi, together with the overseers and deacons:

(Philippians 1:25-26) Convinced of this, I know that I will remain, and I will continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith, {26} so that through my being with you again your joy in Christ Jesus will overflow on account of me.

(Philippians 3:3) For it is we who are the circumcision, we who worship by the Spirit of God, who glory in Christ Jesus, and who put no confidence in the flesh--

(Philippians 3:9) and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ--the righteousness that comes from God and is by faith.

(Philippians 3:14) I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

(Philippians 4:7) And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

(Philippians 4:19) And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

(Philippians 4:21) Greet all the saints in Christ Jesus. The brothers who are with me send greetings.

(Colossians 1:2) To the holy and faithful brothers in Christ at Colosse: Grace and peace to you from God our Father.

(Colossians 1:4) because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all the saints--

(Colossians 1:28) We proclaim him, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone perfect in Christ.

(Colossians 2:5) For though I am absent from you in body, I am present with you in spirit and delight to see how orderly you are and how firm your faith in Christ is.

(Colossians 2:9-10) For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, {10} and you have been given fullness in Christ, who is the head over every power and authority.

(Colossians 2:17) These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ.

(1 Thessalonians 2:14) For you, brothers, became imitators of God's churches in Judea, which are in Christ Jesus: You suffered from your own countrymen the same things those churches suffered from the Jews,

(1 Thessalonians 4:16) For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.

(1 Thessalonians 5:18) give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

(1 Timothy 1:14) The grace of our Lord was poured out on me abundantly, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus.

(1 Timothy 3:13) Those who have served well gain an excellent standing and great assurance in their faith in Christ Jesus.

(2 Timothy 1:1) Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, according to the promise of life that is in Christ Jesus,

(2 Timothy 1:8-9) So do not be ashamed to testify about our Lord, or ashamed of me his prisoner. But join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the power of God, {9} who has saved us and called us to a holy life--not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time,

(2 Timothy 1:13) What you heard from me, keep as the pattern of sound teaching, with faith and love in Christ Jesus.

(2 Timothy 2:1) You then, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.

(2 Timothy 2:10) Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory.

(2 Timothy 3:12) In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted,

(2 Timothy 3:15) and how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

(Philemon 1:6) I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ.

(Philemon 1:8) Therefore, although in Christ I could be bold and order you to do what you ought to do,

(Philemon 1:20) I do wish, brother, that I may have some benefit from you in the Lord; refresh my heart in Christ.

(Philemon 1:23) Epaphras, my fellow prisoner in Christ Jesus, sends you greetings.

(Hebrews 3:14) We have come to share in Christ if we hold firmly till the end the confidence we had at first.

(1 Peter 3:16) keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.

(1 Peter 5:10) And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.

(1 Peter 5:14) Greet one another with a kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ.

(John 10:42) And in that place many believed in Jesus.

(John 12:2) Here a dinner was given in Jesus' honor. Martha served, while Lazarus was among those reclining at the table with him.

(Acts 4:2) They were greatly disturbed because the apostles were teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection of the dead.

(Acts 19:4) Paul said, "John's baptism was a baptism of repentance. He told the people to believe in the one coming after him, that is, in Jesus."

(Romans 3:22) This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference,

(Romans 3:25-26) God presented him as a sacrifice of atonement, through faith in his blood. He did this to demonstrate his justice, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished-- {26} he did it to demonstrate his justice at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus.

(Galatians 2:16) know that a man is not justified by observing the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by observing the law, because by observing the law no one will be justified.

(Galatians 3:22) But the Scripture declares that the whole world is a prisoner of sin, so that what was promised, being given through faith in Jesus Christ, might be given to those who believe.

(Ephesians 4:21) Surely you heard of him and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus.

(Revelation 1:9) I, John, your brother and companion in the suffering and kingdom and patient endurance that are ours in Jesus, was on the island of Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.

(Matthew 27:43) He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God.'"

(Mark 11:22) **"Have faith in God,"** Jesus answered.

(John 14:1) **"Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God ; trust also in me.**

(Acts 16:34) The jailer brought them into his house and set a meal before them; he was filled with joy because he had come to believe in God--he and his whole family.

(Acts 24:14-15) However, I admit that I worship the God of our fathers as a follower of the Way, which they call a sect. I believe everything that agrees with the Law and that is written in the Prophets, {15} and I have the same hope in God as these men, that there will be a resurrection of both the righteous and the wicked.

(Acts 27:25) So keep up your courage, men, for I have faith in God that it will happen just as he told me.

(Romans 5:11) Not only is this so, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.

(Ephesians 3:9) and to make plain to everyone the administration of this mystery, which for ages past was kept hidden in God, who created all things.

(Colossians 3:3) For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.

(1 Thessalonians 1:1) Paul, Silas and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace and peace to you.

(1 Thessalonians 1:8) The Lord's message rang out from you not only in Macedonia and Achaia--your faith in God has become known everywhere. Therefore we do not need to say anything about it,

(2 Thessalonians 1:1) Paul, Silas and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:

(1 Timothy 5:5) The widow who is really in need and left all alone puts her hope in God and continues night and day to pray and to ask God for help.

(1 Timothy 6:17) Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment.

(Titus 3:8) This is a trustworthy saying. And I want you to stress these things, so that those who have trusted in God may be careful to devote themselves to doing what is good. These things are excellent and profitable for everyone.

(Hebrews 6:1) Therefore let us leave the elementary teachings about Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again the foundation of repentance from acts that lead to death, and of faith in God,

(1 Peter 1:21) Through him you believe in God, who raised him from the dead and glorified him, and so your faith and hope are in God.

(1 Peter 3:5) For this is the way the holy women of the past who put their hope in God used to make themselves beautiful. They were submissive to their own husbands,

(1 John 4:15-16) If anyone acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in him and he in God. {16} And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him.

(Acts 5:14) Nevertheless, more and more men and women believed in the Lord and were added to their number.

(Acts 9:42) This became known all over Joppa, and many people believed in the Lord.

(Acts 11:17) So if God gave them the same gift as he gave us, who believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I to think that I could oppose God?"

(Acts 16:15) When she and the members of her household were baptized, she invited us to her home. "If you consider me a believer in the Lord," she said, "come and stay at my house." And she persuaded us.

(Acts 16:31) They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved--you and your household."

(Acts 18:8) Crispus, the synagogue ruler, and his entire household believed in the Lord; and many of the Corinthians who heard him believed and were baptized.

(Romans 14:14) As one who is in the Lord Jesus, I am fully convinced that no food is unclean in itself. But if anyone regards something as unclean, then for him it is unclean.

(Romans 16:2) I ask you to receive her in the Lord in a way worthy of the saints and to give her any help she may need from you, for she has been a great help to many people, including me.

(Romans 16:11-13) Greet Herodion, my relative. Greet those in the household of Narcissus who are in the Lord. {12} Greet Tryphena and Tryphosa, those women who work hard in the Lord. Greet my dear friend Persis, another woman who has worked very hard in the Lord. {13} Greet Rufus, chosen in the Lord, and his mother, who has been a mother to me, too.

(1 Corinthians 1:31) Therefore, as it is written: "Let him who boasts boast in the Lord."

(1 Corinthians 4:17) For this reason I am sending to you Timothy, my son whom I love, who is faithful in the Lord. He will remind you of my way of life in Christ Jesus, which agrees with what I teach everywhere in every church.

(1 Corinthians 9:1-2) Am I not free? Am I not an apostle? Have I not seen Jesus our Lord? Are you not the result of my work in the Lord? {2} Even though I may not be an apostle to others, surely I am to you! For you are the seal of my apostleship in the Lord.

(1 Corinthians 11:11) In the Lord, however, woman is not independent of man, nor is man independent of woman.

(1 Corinthians 15:58) Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.

(1 Corinthians 16:19) The churches in the province of Asia send you greetings. Aquila and Priscilla greet you warmly in the Lord, and so does the church that meets at their house.

(2 Corinthians 10:17) But, "Let him who boasts boast in the Lord."

(Galatians 5:10) I am confident in the Lord that you will take no other view. The one who is throwing you into confusion will pay the penalty, whoever he may be.

(Ephesians 1:15) For this reason, ever since I heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints,

(Ephesians 2:21) In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord.

(Ephesians 4:17) So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking.

(Ephesians 5:8) For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light

(Ephesians 6:10) Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power.

(Ephesians 6:21) Tychicus, the dear brother and faithful servant in the Lord, will tell you everything, so that you also may know how I am and what I am doing.

(Philippians 1:14) Because of my chains, most of the brothers in the Lord have been encouraged to speak the word of God more courageously and fearlessly.

(Philippians 2:19) I hope in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you soon, that I also may be cheered when I receive news about you.

(Philippians 2:24) And I am confident in the Lord that I myself will come soon.

(Philippians 2:29) Welcome him in the Lord with great joy, and honor men like him,

(Philippians 3:1) Finally, my brothers, rejoice in the Lord! It is no trouble for me to write the same things to you again, and it is a safeguard for you.

(Philippians 4:1-2) Therefore, my brothers, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, that is how you should stand firm in the Lord, dear friends! {2} I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to agree with each other in the Lord.

(Philippians 4:4) Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!

(Philippians 4:10) I rejoice greatly in the Lord that at last you have renewed your concern for me. Indeed, you have been concerned, but you had no opportunity to show it.

(Colossians 3:18) Wives, submit to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.

(Colossians 4:7) Tychicus will tell you all the news about me. He is a dear brother, a faithful minister and fellow servant in the Lord.

(Colossians 4:17) Tell Archippus: "See to it that you complete the work you have received in the Lord."

(1 Thessalonians 3:8) For now we really live, since you are standing firm in the Lord.

(1 Thessalonians 4:1) Finally, brothers, we instructed you how to live in order to please God, as in fact you are living. Now we ask you and urge you in the Lord Jesus to do this more and more.

(1 Thessalonians 5:12) Now we ask you, brothers, to respect those who work hard among you, who are over you in the Lord and who admonish you.

(2 Thessalonians 3:4) We have confidence in the Lord that you are doing and will continue to do the things we command.

(2 Thessalonians 3:12) Such people we command and urge in the Lord Jesus Christ to settle down and earn the bread they eat.

(Philemon 1:4-5) I always thank my God as I remember you in my prayers, {5} because I hear about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints.

(Philemon 1:20) I do wish, brother, that I may have some benefit from you in the Lord; refresh my heart in Christ.

(Revelation 14:13) Then I heard a voice from heaven say, "Write: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on." "Yes," says the Spirit, "they will rest from their labor, for their deeds will follow them."
