

## Jesus, The Son, Verses In The New Testament

(Matthew 3:17) And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."

(Matthew 4:3) The tempter came to him and said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread."

(Matthew 4:6) "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down. For it is written: "He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."

(Matthew 8:20) Jesus replied, "Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head."

(Matthew 8:29) "What do you want with us, Son of God?" they shouted. "Have you come here to torture us before the appointed time?"

(Matthew 9:6) But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins. . . ." Then he said to the paralytic, "Get up, take your mat and go home."

(Matthew 9:27) As Jesus went on from there, two blind men followed him, calling out, "Have mercy on us, Son of David!"

(Matthew 10:23) When you are persecuted in one place, flee to another. I tell you the truth, you will not finish going through the cities of Israel before the Son of Man comes.

(Matthew 11:19) The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Here is a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and "sinners." ' But wisdom is proved right by her actions."

(Matthew 11:27) "All things have been committed to me by my Father. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.

(Matthew 12:8) For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."

(Matthew 12:23) All the people were astonished and said, "Could this be the Son of David?"

(Matthew 12:32) Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but anyone who speaks against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven, either in this age or in the age to come.

(Matthew 12:40) For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

(Matthew 13:37) He answered, "The one who sowed the good seed is the Son of Man.

(Matthew 13:41) The Son of Man will send out his angels, and they will weed out of his kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil.

(Matthew 14:33) Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

(Matthew 15:22) A Canaanite woman from that vicinity came to him, crying out, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on me! My daughter is suffering terribly from demon-possession."

(Matthew 16:13) When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?"

(Matthew 16:16) Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

(Matthew 16:27-28) For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what he has done. {28} I tell you the truth, some who are standing here will not taste death before they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom."

(Matthew 17:5) While he was still speaking, a bright cloud enveloped them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!"

(Matthew 17:9) As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus instructed them, "Don't tell anyone what you have seen, until the Son of Man has been raised from the dead."

(Matthew 17:12) But I tell you, Elijah has already come, and they did not recognize him, but have done to him everything they wished. In the same way the Son of Man is going to suffer at their hands."

(Matthew 17:22) When they came together in Galilee, he said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into the hands of men.

(Matthew 19:28) Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, at the renewal of all things, when the Son of Man sits on his glorious throne, you who have followed me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

(Matthew 20:18) "We are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and the teachers of the law. They will condemn him to death

(Matthew 20:28) just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

(Matthew 20:30-31) Two blind men were sitting by the roadside, and when they heard that Jesus was going by, they shouted, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on us!" {31} The crowd rebuked them and told them to be quiet, but they shouted all the louder, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on us!"

(Matthew 21:9) The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Hosanna in the highest!"

(Matthew 21:15) But when the chief priests and the teachers of the law saw the wonderful things he did and the children shouting in the temple area, "Hosanna to the Son of David," they were indignant.

(Matthew 21:28) "What do you think? There was a man who had two sons. He went to the first and said, 'Son, go and work today in the vineyard.'

(Matthew 24:27) For as lightning that comes from the east is visible even in the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.

(Matthew 24:30) "At that time the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, and all the nations of the earth will mourn. They will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of the sky, with power and great glory.

(Matthew 24:36-37) "No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. {37} As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.

(Matthew 24:39) and they knew nothing about what would happen until the flood came and took them all away. That is how it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.

(Matthew 24:44) So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him.

(Matthew 25:31) "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his throne in heavenly glory.

(Matthew 26:2) "As you know, the Passover is two days away--and the Son of Man will be handed over to be crucified."

(Matthew 26:24) The Son of Man will go just as it is written about him. But woe to that man who betrays the Son of Man! It would be better for him if he had not been born."

(Matthew 26:45) Then he returned to the disciples and said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? Look, the hour is near, and the Son of Man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.

(Matthew 26:63-64) But Jesus remained silent. The high priest said to him, "I charge you under oath by the living God: Tell us if you are the Christ, the Son of God." {64} "Yes, it is as you say," Jesus replied. "But I say to all of you: In the future you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven."

(Matthew 27:40) and saying, "You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!"

(Matthew 27:43) He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God.'

(Matthew 27:54) When the centurion and those with him who were guarding Jesus saw the earthquake and all that had happened, they were terrified, and exclaimed, "Surely he was the Son of God!"

(Matthew 28:19) Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

(Mark 1:1) The beginning of the gospel about Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

(Mark 1:11) And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased."

(Mark 2:5) When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven."

(Mark 2:10-11) But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins . . . ." He said to the paralytic, {11} "I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home."

(Mark 2:28) So the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath."

(Mark 3:11) Whenever the evil spirits saw him, they fell down before him and cried out, "You are the Son of God."

(Mark 5:7) He shouted at the top of his voice, "What do you want with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? Swear to God that you won't torture me!"

(Mark 8:31) He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again.

(Mark 8:38) **If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels.**"

(Mark 9:7) Then a cloud appeared and enveloped them, and a voice came from the cloud: "This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him!"

(Mark 9:9) As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus gave them orders not to tell anyone what they had seen until the Son of Man had risen from the dead.

(Mark 9:12) Jesus replied, **"To be sure, Elijah does come first, and restores all things. Why then is it written that the Son of Man must suffer much and be rejected?"**

(Mark 9:31) because he was teaching his disciples. He said to them, **"The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into the hands of men. They will kill him, and after three days he will rise."**

(Mark 10:33) **"We are going up to Jerusalem," he said, "and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and teachers of the law. They will condemn him to death and will hand him over to the Gentiles,**

(Mark 10:45-48) **For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.**" {46} Then they came to Jericho. As Jesus and his disciples, together with a large crowd, were leaving the city, a blind man, Bartimaeus (that is, the Son of Timaeus), was sitting by the roadside begging. {47} When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" {48} Many rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!"

(Mark 13:26) **"At that time men will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory.**

(Mark 13:32) **"No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.**

(Mark 14:21) **The Son of Man will go just as it is written about him. But woe to that man who betrays the Son of Man! It would be better for him if he had not been born."**

(Mark 14:41) Returning the third time, he said to them, **"Are you still sleeping and resting? Enough! The hour has come. Look, the Son of Man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.**

(Mark 14:61-62) But Jesus remained silent and gave no answer. Again the high priest asked him, "Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?" {62} **"I am,"** said Jesus. **"And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven."**

(Mark 15:39) And when the centurion, who stood there in front of Jesus, heard his cry and saw how he died, he said, "Surely this man was the Son of God!"

(Luke 1:32) He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David,

(Luke 1:35) The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God.

(Luke 2:48) When his parents saw him, they were astonished. His mother said to him, "Son, why have you treated us like this? Your father and I have been anxiously searching for you."

(Luke 3:22) and the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased."

(Luke 4:3) The devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, tell this stone to become bread."

(Luke 4:9) The devil led him to Jerusalem and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down from here.

(Luke 4:41) Moreover, demons came out of many people, shouting, "You are the Son of God!" But he rebuked them and would not allow them to speak, because they knew he was the Christ.

(Luke 5:24) **But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins. . . .** He said to the paralyzed man, **"I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home."**

(Luke 6:5) Then Jesus said to them, **"The Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."**

(Luke 6:22) **Blessed are you when men hate you, when they exclude you and insult you and reject your name as evil, because of the Son of Man.**

(Luke 7:34) **The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and you say, 'Here is a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and "sinners."**

(Luke 8:28) When he saw Jesus, he cried out and fell at his feet, shouting at the top of his voice, "What do you want with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg you, don't torture me!"

(Luke 9:22) And he said, **"The Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life."**

(Luke 9:26) If anyone is ashamed of me and my words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his glory and in the glory of the Father and of the holy angels.

(Luke 9:35) A voice came from the cloud, saying, "This is my Son, whom I have chosen; listen to him."

(Luke 9:44) "Listen carefully to what I am about to tell you: The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into the hands of men."

(Luke 9:58) Jesus replied, "Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head."

(Luke 10:22) "All things have been committed to me by my Father. No one knows who the Son is except the Father, and no one knows who the Father is except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him."

(Luke 11:30) For as Jonah was a sign to the Ninevites, so also will the Son of Man be to this generation.

(Luke 12:8) "I tell you, whoever acknowledges me before men, the Son of Man will also acknowledge him before the angels of God.

(Luke 12:10) And everyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but anyone who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven.

(Luke 12:40) You also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him."

(Luke 16:25) "But Abraham replied, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here and you are in agony.

(Luke 17:22) Then he said to his disciples, "The time is coming when you will long to see one of the days of the Son of Man, but you will not see it.

(Luke 17:24) For the Son of Man in his day will be like the lightning, which flashes and lights up the sky from one end to the other.

(Luke 17:26) "Just as it was in the days of Noah, so also will it be in the days of the Son of Man.

(Luke 17:30) "It will be just like this on the day the Son of Man is revealed.

(Luke 18:8) I tell you, he will see that they get justice, and quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth?"

(Luke 18:31) Jesus took the Twelve aside and told them, "We are going up to Jerusalem, and everything that is written by the prophets about the Son of Man will be fulfilled."

(Luke 18:38-39) He called out, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" {39} Those who led the way rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!"

(Luke 19:10) For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost."

(Luke 20:41) Then Jesus said to them, "How is it that they say the Christ is the Son of David?"

(Luke 21:27) At that time they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.

(Luke 21:36) Be always on the watch, and pray that you may be able to escape all that is about to happen, and that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man."

(Luke 22:22) The Son of Man will go as it has been decreed, but woe to that man who betrays him."

(Luke 22:48) but Jesus asked him, "Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?"

(Luke 22:69-70) But from now on, the Son of Man will be seated at the right hand of the mighty God." {70} They all asked, "Are you then the Son of God?" He replied, "You are right in saying I am."

(Luke 24:7) "The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, be crucified and on the third day be raised again."

(John 1:34) I have seen and I testify that this is the Son of God."

(John 1:49) Then Nathanael declared, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the King of Israel."

(John 1:51) He then added, "I tell you the truth, you shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man."

(John 3:13-14) No one has ever gone into heaven except the one who came from heaven—the Son of Man. {14} Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up,

(John 3:16-18) "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. {17} For God did not send

his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. {18} Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.

(John 3:35-36) The Father loves the Son and has placed everything in his hands. {36} Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him."

(John 5:19-23) Jesus gave them this answer: "I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. {20} For the Father loves the Son and shows him all he does. Yes, to your amazement he will show him even greater things than these. {21} For just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, even so the Son gives life to whom he is pleased to give it. {22} Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, {23} that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him.

(John 5:25-27) I tell you the truth, a time is coming and has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who hear will live. {26} For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself. {27} And he has given him authority to judge because he is the Son of Man.

(John 6:27) Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On him God the Father has placed his seal of approval."

(John 6:40) For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day."

(John 6:53) Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you.

(John 6:62) What if you see the Son of Man ascend to where he was before!

(John 8:28) So Jesus said, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am the one I claim to be and that I do nothing on my own but speak just what the Father has taught me.

(John 8:36) So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

(John 9:35) Jesus heard that they had thrown him out, and when he found him, he said, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?"

(John 10:36) what about the one whom the Father set apart as his very own and sent into the world? Why then do you accuse me of blasphemy because I said, 'I am God's Son'?

(John 11:4) When he heard this, Jesus said, "This sickness will not end in death. No, it is for God's glory so that God's Son may be glorified through it."

(John 11:27) "Yes, Lord," she told him, "I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, who was to come into the world."

(John 12:23) Jesus replied, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified."

(John 12:34) The crowd spoke up, "We have heard from the Law that the Christ will remain forever, so how can you say, 'The Son of Man must be lifted up'? Who is this 'Son of Man'?"

(John 13:31-32) When he was gone, Jesus said, "Now is the Son of Man glorified and God is glorified in him. {32} If God is glorified in him, God will glorify the Son in himself, and will glorify him at once."

(John 14:13) And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father.

(John 17:1) After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed: "Father, the time has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you."

(John 19:7) The Jews insisted, "We have a law, and according to that law he must die, because he claimed to be the Son of God."

(John 20:31) But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

(Acts 4:36) Joseph, a Levite from Cyprus, whom the apostles called Barnabas (which means Son of Encouragement),

(Acts 7:56) "Look," he said, "I see heaven open and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."

(Acts 9:20) At once he began to preach in the synagogues that Jesus is the Son of God.

(Acts 13:33) he has fulfilled for us, their children, by raising up Jesus. As it is written in the second Psalm: "'You are my Son; today I have become your Father.'

(Romans 1:3-4) regarding his Son, who as to his human nature was a descendant of David, {4} and who through the Spirit of holiness was declared with power to be the Son of God by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord.

(Romans 1:9) God, whom I serve with my whole heart in preaching the gospel of his Son, is my witness how constantly I remember you

(Romans 5:10) For if, when we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!

(Romans 8:3) For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the sinful nature, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful man to be a sin offering. And so he condemned sin in sinful man,

(Romans 8:29) For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.

(Romans 8:32) He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all--how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

(1 Corinthians 1:9) God, who has called you into fellowship with his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, is faithful.

(1 Corinthians 15:28) When he has done this, then the Son himself will be made subject to him who put everything under him, so that God may be all in all.

(2 Corinthians 1:19) For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by me and Silas and Timothy, was not "Yes" and "No," but in him it has always been "Yes."

(Galatians 1:16) to reveal his Son in me so that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not consult any man,

(Galatians 2:20) I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

(Galatians 4:4) But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law,

(Galatians 4:6) Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father."

(Ephesians 4:13) until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

(Colossians 1:13) For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves,

(1 Thessalonians 1:10) and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead--Jesus, who rescues us from the coming wrath.

(Hebrews 1:2-3) but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe. {3} The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven.

(Hebrews 1:5) For to which of the angels did God ever say, "You are my Son; today I have become your Father " ? Or again, "I will be his Father, and he will be my Son"?

(Hebrews 1:8) But about the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever, and righteousness will be the scepter of your kingdom.

(Hebrews 4:14) Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has gone through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess.

(Hebrews 5:5) So Christ also did not take upon himself the glory of becoming a high priest. But God said to him, "You are my Son; today I have become your Father."

(Hebrews 6:6) if they fall away, to be brought back to repentance, because to their loss they are crucifying the Son of God all over again and subjecting him to public disgrace.

(Hebrews 7:3) Without father or mother, without genealogy, without beginning of days or end of life, like the Son of God he remains a priest forever.

(Hebrews 7:28) For the law appoints as high priests men who are weak; but the oath, which came after the law, appointed the Son, who has been made perfect forever.

(Hebrews 10:29) How much more severely do you think a man deserves to be punished who has trampled the Son of God under foot, who has treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant that sanctified him, and who has insulted the Spirit of grace?

(2 Peter 1:17) For he received honor and glory from God the Father when the voice came to him from the Majestic Glory, saying, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."

(1 John 1:3) We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ.

(1 John 1:7) But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

(1 John 2:22-24) Who is the liar? It is the man who denies that Jesus is the Christ. Such a man is the antichrist--he denies the Father and the Son. {23} No one who denies the Son has the Father; whoever acknowledges the Son has the Father also. {24} See that what

you have heard from the beginning remains in you. If it does, you also will remain in the Son and in the Father.

(1 John 3:8) He who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work.

(1 John 3:23) And this is his command: to believe in the name of his Son, Jesus Christ, and to love one another as he commanded us.

(1 John 4:9-10) This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. {10} This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

(1 John 4:14-15) And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world. {15} If anyone acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in him and he in God.

(1 John 5:5) Who is it that overcomes the world? Only he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.

(1 John 5:9-13) We accept man's testimony, but God's testimony is greater because it is the testimony of God, which he has given about his Son. {10} Anyone who believes in the Son of God has this testimony in his heart. Anyone who does not believe God has made him out to be a liar, because he has not believed the testimony God has given about his Son. {11} And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. {12} He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. {13} I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.

(1 John 5:20) We know also that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true. And we are in him who is true--even in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life.

(2 John 1:3) Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and from Jesus Christ, the Father's Son, will be with us in truth and love.

(2 John 1:9) Anyone who runs ahead and does not continue in the teaching of Christ does not have God; whoever continues in the teaching has both the Father and the Son.

(Revelation 2:18) "To the angel of the church in Thyatira write: These are the words of the Son of God, whose eyes are like blazing fire and whose feet are like burnished bronze.
